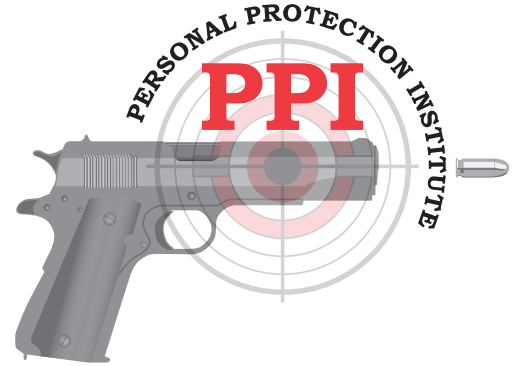
Saturday, April 28th – Pre-requisite NRA Basic Pistol

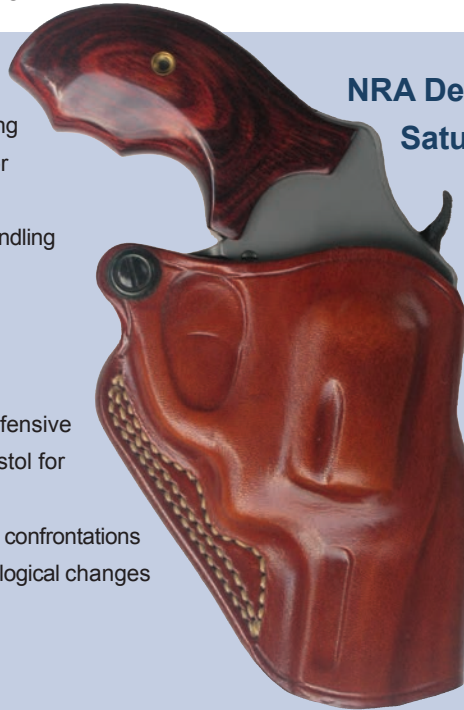

- Flash sight picture
- Reload under stress
- Clear common stoppages – immediate action drills

- Qualify for the NRA Defensive Pistol Certificate

Students must provide their own:

Quality pistol appropriate for concealed carry – minimum of 9mm or .38 Special

Quality strong side hip holster – form fitted leather or kydex, must cover trigger/trigger guard

Quality Belt, designed to carry a holster and a firearm

Quality factory ammunition suitable for practice – 200+ rounds

Spare magazines or speed loaders with appropriate pouches – at least two spares

Clothing appropriate for concealed carry

Eye & Ear protection

Candidates must satisfactorily complete NRA Defensive Pistol Range firing exercise and receive the endorsement of the NRA Training Counselor before a certificate is awarded.
